- 1. EVERY PROJECT STARTS WITH THE END TAG
- 2. Check the end use. Make sure it matches your needs and the requirements of your local building code.
- 3. Third-party inspection gives you confidence in the performance of your project.

UC4A - Ground Contact, General Use

Wood treated to **(UC4A) GROUND CONTACT** standards is ideal for general-use situations where the wood may contact moisture, the ground, or be installed in a manner that subjects the wood to comparable ground contact conditions.
